#### US Government, IRS: due May 15<sup>th</sup> if your calendar year ends December 31.

## California Franchise Tax Board (CA FTB)

Form 199 N gross receipts equal to or less than \$50,000 due every year by the 15th day of the 5th month after the close of your tax year.

SI-100, Statement of Information, Due within 90 days of initial registration and every 2 years thereafter. It may be filed online. There is a \$20 filing fee.
